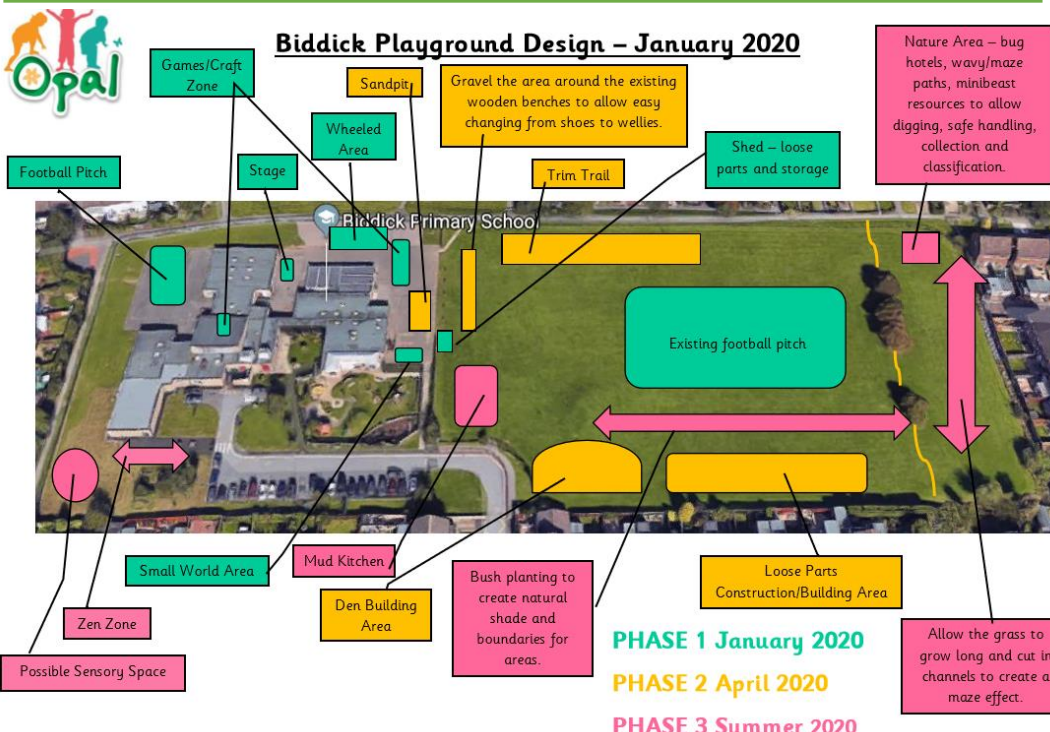
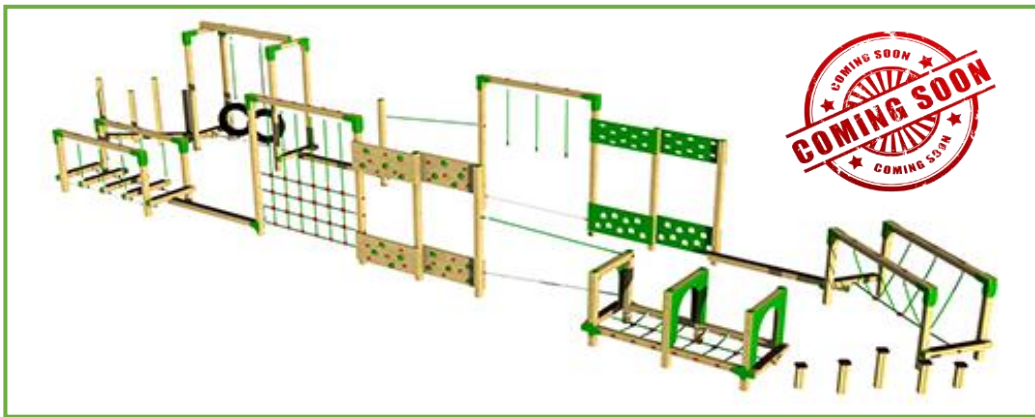
Tree Planting Afternoon
